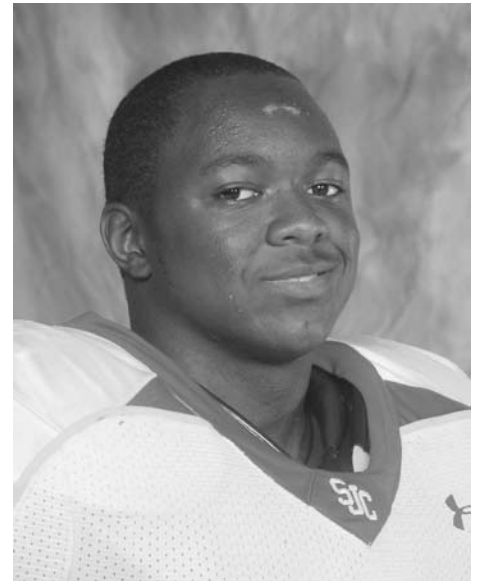


2007 Team Captains

Antwon Bailey Senior -- No. 2

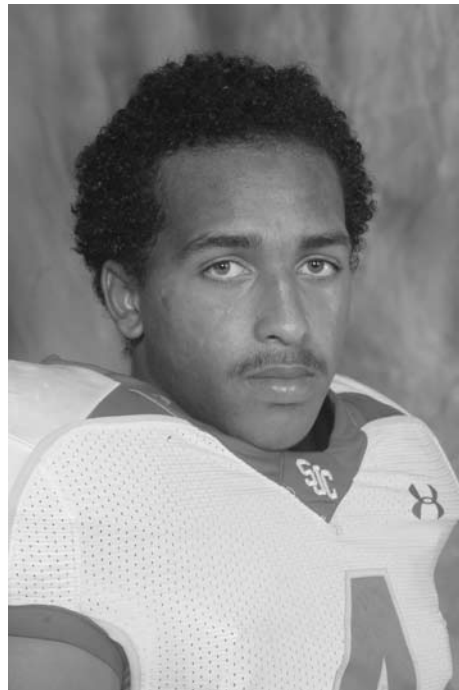
As a sophomore, Bailey was named SJC's Offensive MVP. He ran the ball 101 times for a 6.4 average and eight touchdowns. He also posted 78 broken tackles. He even took several snaps at quarterback. As a junior, Bailey scored 15 touchdowns and was again named Offensive MVP. He led the team in rushing and was second on the team in receiving. His true diversity of talent was highlighted in the West Catholic game when he ran for a touchdown, had a reception for a touchdown, and had a punt return for a touchdown. He finished the 2006 season with 138 broken tackles. In school, Bailey has made the honor roll and tutors underclassmen in mathematics. He served as team captain during his junior season as well.

Anthony Coleman Senior -- No. 4

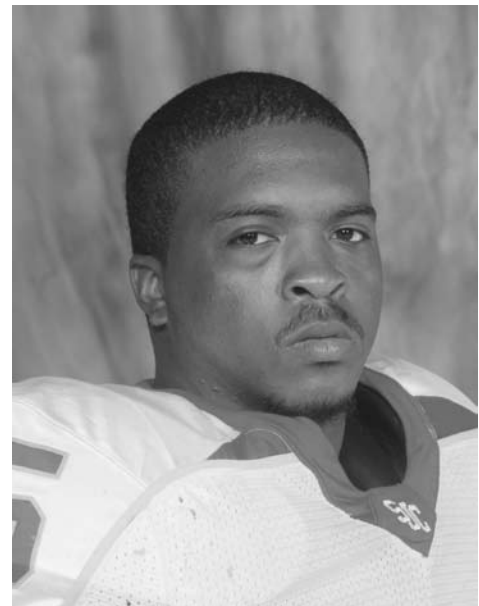
As a sophomore, Coleman made the varsity football team as a wide receiver and had 11 catches. As a junior, he recorded 31 catches for 484 yards and established himself as one of the best blockers in the league. He also ran the ball 22 times, scoring six rushing touchdowns with a 7.5 yard-per-carry average. Defensively at linebacker, Coleman registered 50 tackles over the two seasons and will be a two-way starter this season. As one of the stronger players on the team, he bench pressed 355 pounds this August.
