ST. JOHN'S VOLLEYBALL CAMP

The camp is designed to instruct each camper in all the fundamentals in the sport of volleyball including passing, setting, hitting, blocking, team play, and strength and conditioning. Classroom exercise to understand the regulations of the game, as well as positioning and rotation may be used. This may include video and guest speakers to further a camper's knowledge and enthusiasm of the sport.

Campers should be dressed appropriately for camp with a pair of sneakers, knee pads, shorts or compression shorts, and a t-shirt. Each camper should also bring a lock for the locker room and a lunch. A limited menu to purchase food will be offered. Each camper will receive a camp t-shirt.

EXTENDED CARE

St. John's Volleyball Camp will operate between the hours of 9:00am and 3:30pm. Extended care for campers will operate at a rate of \$5.00 per hour from 7:30am to 8:30am, and from 4:00pm to 5:00pm.

REGISTRATION

ATHLETIC TRAINER

The St. John's Volleyball Camp will provide a Certified Athletic Trainer to handle any possible injuries that may occur. The Athletic Trainer, along with St. John's College High School and the Volleyball Coach Staff, has an Emergency Action Plan (EAP) in place in case of any severe injury that occurs.
