SUBJECT: CAMP SUCCESS '10

The Junior ROTC Summer Camp Success for the Washington DC Public Schools and participating schools from Maryland, Delaware and Virginia will be conducted at Fort A. P. Bowling Green, VA, during the period **23-28 June 2010**.

The purpose of the camp is to provide an informative, challenging, safe and activity-filled leadership experience which will motivate our cadets to pursue individual and team excellence. Some of the planned camp highlights include:

- Physical Fitness/Sports Competition
- A Leadership Reaction Course
- Land Navigation
- Map Reading (Concurrent training)
- Academic Competition (Concurrent training)
- Rappelling and Confidence Course Exercises
- Drug Prevention (Concurrent training)
- Survival Training
- Drown proofing
- Drill Competition
- A Graduation Ceremony
- Group Dynamics Leadership Field Trip

All cadets will be billeted at Fort A. P. Hill, VA. Female cadets along with adult female supervisory personnel will be in female areas and will participate equally in all scheduled activities. All meals (lunch June 23 through lunch 28 June 2010) will be provided at no cost to the cadets. Junior ROTC instructors will serve as camp cadre and staff. **The camp headquarters, building # 1630 will be staffed twenty-four hours a day and can be reached in an emergency at (804) 633-8601/14/39/41. The Installation Staff Duty Officer phone # (804) 633-8201/8207 will also be available in case of an emergency.**

We have diligently sought to keep the overall cost of this summer camp experiences down. Consequently, **the total cost for each cadet will be \$50.26**, and this will be applied to cover the cost of insurance, tee shirts, and admissions for Kings Dominion. Schools must make all checks payable to "AHS" and forward to Atholton High School JROTC, 6520 Freetown Road, Columbia, MD 21044.

The final due date for all camp fees is 14 May 2010. Only city, county, school, SAI and AI checks will be accepted.

In addition, radios, beepers, tape/CD players, televisions, cell phones, expensive jewelry and weapons of any type **will not be brought to camp**. This will be cause for immediate expulsion.

Addressees are cordially invited to attend the graduation ceremony scheduled for 9:00 AM, on Monday 28 June 2010, conducted in the Wilcox area at Fort A.P. Hill, VA. If you plan to attend, please notify your child's instructor prior to 1 June 2010. You may contact the Camp Headquarters starting Wednesday, 23 June 2010.

We are looking forward to an exciting fun-filled safe camp, and we fully expect that it will be a memorable experience for all attendees.
