Summer project. This counts as a test grade for the first quarter:

- Write out part 1 on loose leaf. Type parts 2, 3, & 4. Put all in a two-pocket folder labeled with YOUR NAME and Sp4 on the cover of the folder and on each part.

Part I – keep a journal in Spanish of your activities for 6 weeks of your summer – one entry per week – At each of the 6 entries, write 7-8 complete sentences, describing 3 or 4 different activities you did that week. Vary the activities you include, not repeating the same from week to week. So you can practice what you have learned in Spanish 1-3, include a combination of tenses, commands (using quotations), newly acquired concepts and vocabulary. Write legibly in ink, skip lines – not crossing out - on one side only of the sheet.

Part II. – go to www.stjohns-chs.org/language/cm/sjc040.htm From the links given, find and print out 6 exercises to practice: 1] stem changing verbs present/pretérito; 2] commands (tú afirmativo and tú negativo); 3] future tense - irregular verbs; 4] imperfect vs pretérito; 5] clauses using subjunctive (emotion, doubt & indirect command). 6] present tense of irregular verbs. Complete the exercises on your 6 printouts and put them in your folder.

Part III– Research your assigned country where Spanish is spoken **and Part IV** here. Your assigned country is based on the first letter of your last name [A-F- **Ecuador**; G-L – **Perú**; N-P – **Bolivia**; Q-T – **Colombia**; U-Z - **Venezuela**] Plan a 5-day trip to 3 important cities in your assigned country.

- Describe your 5-day itinerary in English and list 15 basic facts that you learn about that country, the traditions of the people, the government, the current issues facing the nation, and the natural resources.
- On the cover sheet, put a map showing your three important cities.

Part IV - eat in a restaurant (not including Chipotle, Baja Fresh, Qdoba, or California Tortilla) with food from one of the 5 named South American countries listed. Write a 60 word review in English of the restaurant and the meal you ate.
